 - dutiable and prohibited goods; and
 - cash, bearer negotiable instrument or both exceeding USD10,000 equivalent.
- Please read the **Important Notice** below before completing this form. Declaration for a person below 12 years old may be made by his guardian. The completed form must be submitted to a Customs officer on duty.
- You are **NOT** allowed to bring into or out of Malaysia, Ringgit Malaysia exceeding USD10,000 equivalent unless with written approval of Bank Negara Malaysia (Central Bank of Malaysia) ("BNM"). Any amount in excess of the above limit shall be deemed as prohibited goods.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Under Malaysian Law:

- Under Malaysian law, every person arriving in or leaving Malaysia must declare all dutiable or prohibited goods, and cash and/or BNI exceeding USD10,000 equivalent in his possession either on his person, in any baggage or in any vehicle to a Customs officer. Failure to make a declaration is an offence.
- A Customs officer may conduct examination of any person, baggage or vehicle.
- Goods exempted from payment of customs duty per person:
 - Wine, spirit, beer or malt liquor not exceeding 1 liter in all;
 - Wearing apparels not exceeding 3 pieces and footwear not exceeding one pair;
 - Food preparation to a total value not exceeding RM150.00;
 - Portable electrically or battery-operated appliance for personal care and hygiene not exceeding 1 unit each; and
 - All goods other than the above, excluding tyres and tubes, to a total value not exceeding RM500.00 for land & sea border and RM 1,000.00 for air border.
- Exemption of duties is subject to the conditions stated under the prevailing exemption order.
